



Watercolor Supply List

Aug 29-Sept 1 Watercolor Workshop in Lodore Canyon

A watercolor block, precut thick watercolor paper, or illustration board.

An array of brushes: I like to have a couple of round sables (Loew-Cornells are nice) in sizes #6 and #4 and a flat sable #10.

Feel free to bring watercolor pencils or drawing tools you might like to use.

A hard lead pencil and a needed eraser

A travel watercolor kit works for me. You can bring tubes if you prefer.

Something that works as a palette. Of course, there are portable fold-out travel ones.

Around 5 sheets of paper towels

A container for dipping and rinsing (I have a collapsible Japanese one)

A junky plastic water bottle to carry river water to your location.

If you have watercolored before and know what you like to use, please feel free to bring those tools and supplies. I will also bring an assortment of supplies to fill in for any forgotten or needed items. I also made a goofy video of the supplies I use. I will have Holiday River Expeditions send it to you.

I can almost always fit my supplies into a large plastic zip-lock bag to keep things together and dry.
